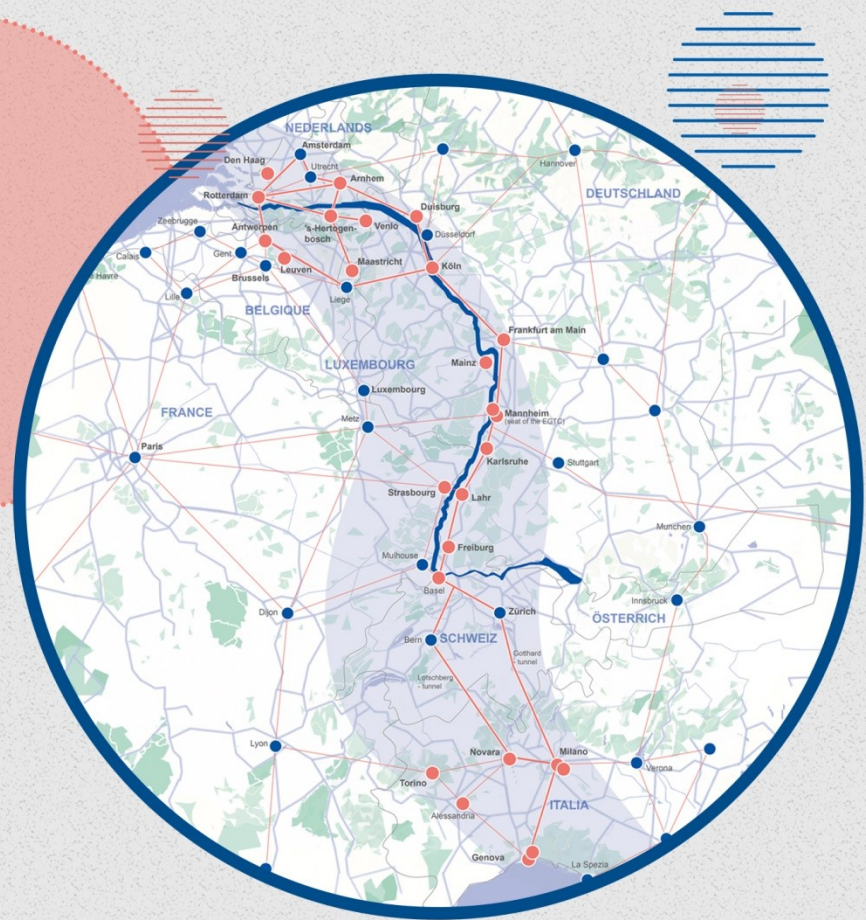

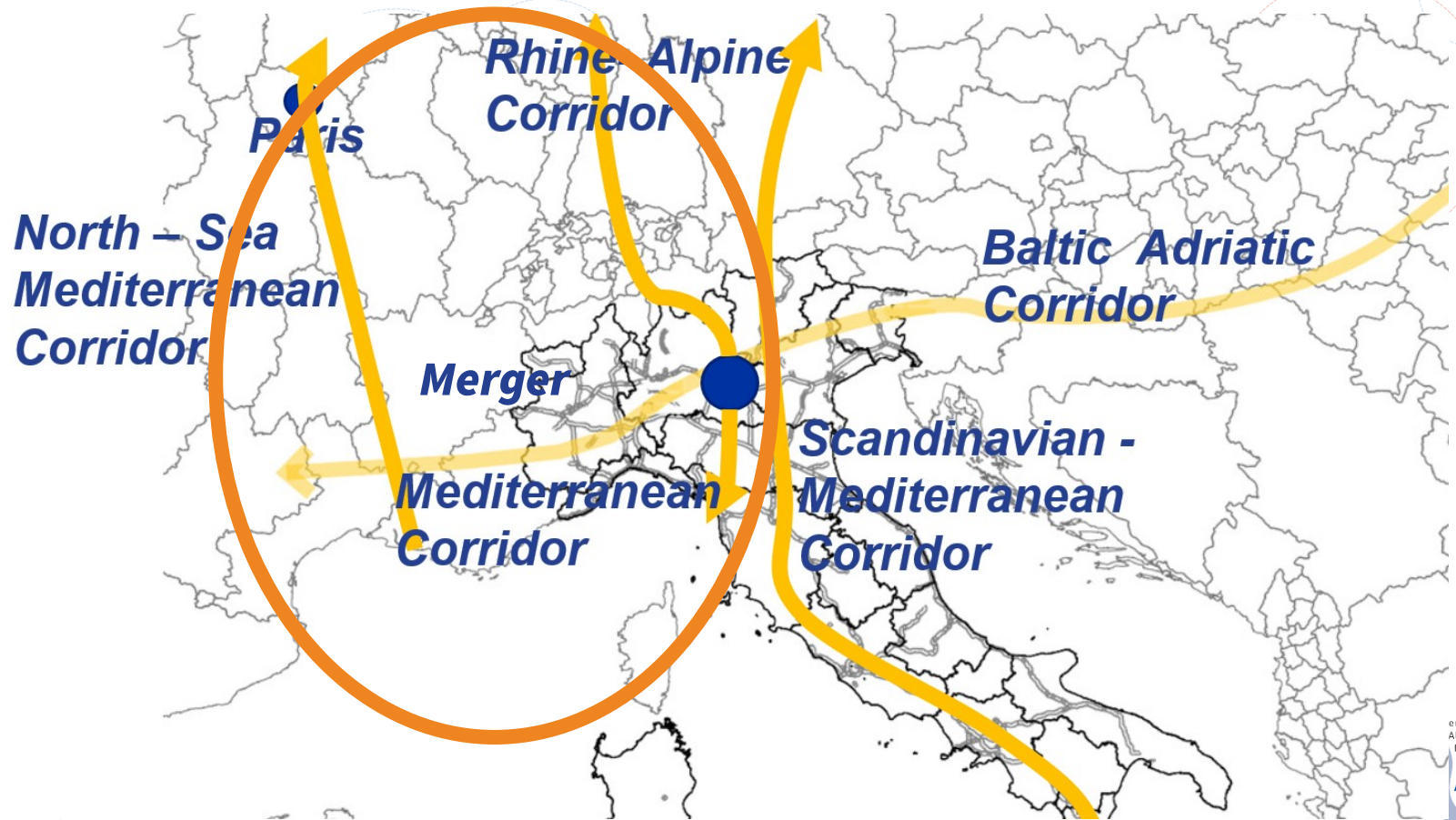

# Logistic Agents Approach of EGTC

## Overview

- Implementation of a modal shift approach inspired by the Dutch Joint Corridors Off-Road Program – regional players supporting logistic sector
- Logistic agents facilitate cross-border operation by
  - Helping regional actors streamline processes for cross-border operation
  - Inform parties (regions, companies) about opportunities in modal shift
  - Act as liaison across regions for involved parties
- Roll out of the ecosystem approach by training and supporting logistic agents

# Characteristics

- Prototypical implementation on the public railways in combination with passenger transport
- Use of free capacities in commuter trains, street trams and busses
- Use of existing resources / driving personnel + rolling stock
- direct transport of goods from regional distribution centres directly into the city

# Challenges

- IT interfaces to logistics industry service providers required
- Use of a delivery robot and development and Testing of a load safety device
- Acceptance among passengers and passers-by
- Short loading and unloading times according to the passenger changeover time (approx. 20-40 seconds)
- Liability issue with additional transport of goods
